



2012 EDUCATION & FORESTRY GRANTS INFORMATION SHEET

Lake Taupo Charitable Trust will make grants available for the academic year on an annual basis.

Objectives

To enhance Ngati Tuwharetoa economic development by providing education and training grants in fields of expertise that will benefit the tribe. Areas identified as requiring encouragement are forestry, cultural, finance, management, education, science, health, agriculture and law.

Administration

Lake Taupo Charitable Trust, set up by Lake Taupo Forest Trust, administers the grants. The Kaitiaki of the Trust will allocate these grants in the current year of application. The closing date is Friday 29th June 2012 at 4.30pm. All applicants will be notified in writing by August of the outcome.

Value of Grants

The value of grants will not be known until all applications have been received and processed. If you study forestry your application will be considered as a forestry grant in recognition of the Charitable Trusts priority to encourage study in this area.

Persons eligible

The following criteria are to be met by all applicants:

- An owner or descendant of an owner
- Studying full-time or part-time on an NZQA course at an NZQA accredited Tertiary Institute *for example:* University, Polytechnic, Whare Wananga, Private Training Establishment & other. This **does not** include Secondary School.
- To advise Tuwharetoa **hapu** affiliation
- Focus and commitment to studies and aims

Applicants are encouraged to take courses in Maori language and culture to supplement their studies.

Application forms

The following applies to all applicants:

- Fully complete all parts of the application form;
- Read and complete course details section;
- Provide a printed bank account number from your bank;
- You are to provide photocopies of any attachments;
- Please do not include with your application bulky folders or photos

The Kaitiaki will review payment made to any student who may fail to satisfactorily complete any year or course of study or who indulges in any form of dishonourable behaviour which discredits the grant and the Lake Taupo Forest Trust or its Charitable Trust.
